Ages are figured as of January 1st, 2023

Tiny Miss: 4-6	Little Miss: 7-9	Preteen Miss: 10-12
Teen Miss: 13-15	Junior Miss: 16-18	Miss: 19-24

MAKEUP

Princess of America is a natural pageant system. Makeup guidelines apply during ALL areas of competition. This includes the required areas for a state or regional title, Superstar, Ambassador, and all optionals including photogenic.

Tiny Miss and Little Miss divisions should wear no noticeable makeup.

Preteen Miss division is allowed to wear light, natural makeup. Use caution with makeup. Judges are instructed that girls should look age appropriate so makeup can work against you if you are not careful.

Teen Miss, Junior Miss, and Miss contestants can be more glamorous but should still look their age.

Makeup guidelines apply during all competitions: required areas and all optional competitions including Superstar and Ambassador.

AREAS OF COMPETITION (REQUIRED)

INTERVIEW

Each contestant will have a personal interview with each of our judges. Questions will be age-appropriate, conversational, and will help the judges learn more about each girl. The judges are looking for personality, confidence, and the ability to express themselves verbally. Tiny Miss and Little Miss contestants will have 1 minute with each judge. Preteen Miss and Teen Miss contestants will have 2 minutes with each judge. Junior Miss and Miss contestants will have 3 minutes with each judge.

WARDROBE: Interview Outfit (dress, suit, pantsuit, etc.) No Jeans.

PERSONAL INTRODUCTION

Each contestant will introduce herself on stage. You may include things like your name, hometown, activities you enjoy, future goals, or something interesting about yourself. The introduction will be judged on confidence, personality, articulation, and presentation. The best introductions are 15-30 seconds long. Introductions are not timed but judges are instructed that introductions should not drag on.

WARDROBE: Interview Outfit.

FORMAL WEAR

Contestant will appear on stage in the formal wear competition. This portion of competition is judged on poise, confidence, and presentation. *WARDROBE:* Gown of your choice. Gown should be floor length and age appropriate. Slits should be a modest height. We are not looking for anything too sexy or revealing.

ON-STAGE QUESTION

Contestants, except for those in the Tiny Miss division, will be asked an on-stage question. Teen Miss, Junior Miss, and Miss divisions will not know what questions will be asked. Little Miss & Preteen Miss divisions will receive a list of potential questions and will be given the list at pageant check in. The questions will be age appropriate and not political.

WARDROBE: Wear your formal wear gown.

NATIONAL TITLES

We will crown 10 national titleholders! These lucky ladies will become the faces of Princess of America for the next year. They will be the recipients of the national prize package, which includes custom national crown and banner, trophy, cash award, custom POA gifts, professional photo shoots, queens trip, and more!

• LITTLE MISS-Highest scoring delegate of age division in the required areas of competition.

• **PRETEEN MISS**-Highest scoring delegate of age division in the required areas of competition.

• **TEEN MISS**-Highest scoring delegate of the age division in the required areas of competition.

• JUNIOR MISS-Highest scoring delegate of age division in the required areas of competition.

• **MISS**-Highest scoring delegate of the age division in the required areas of competition.

• JUNIOR SUPERSTAR-Highest scoring talent contender in the Tiny Miss, Little Miss, and Preteen Miss age divisions combined, who has not already been awarded a national title. (See page 5)

• **SUPERSTAR**-Highest scoring talent contender in the Teen Miss, Junior Miss, and Miss age divisions combined, who has not already been awarded a national title. (See page 5)

• JUNIOR AMBASSADOR-Highest scoring Ambassador contender in the Tiny Miss, Little Miss, and Preteen Miss age divisions combined, who has not already been awarded a national title. (See page 5)

• **AMBASSADOR**-Highest scoring Ambassador contender in the Teen Miss, Junior Miss, and Miss age divisions combined, who has not already been awarded a national title. (See page 5)

TITLE OPPORTUNITIES

Princess of America is proud to crown 10 national titleholders! Each of these prestigious titles will be awarded the same amazing prize package and have the same opportunities during her reign. In addition to our six age division titles, we will award 4 additional titles. The competitions listed below are optional and require an additional fee. A brief description of each additional title is provided below.

SUPERSTAR & JUNIOR SUPERSTAR

The Superstar competition is a way to showcase your talents! Entries have a time limit of 2 minutes 30 seconds. Points will be deducted for exceeding this time limit. Live accompaniment is not allowed. Only the delegate may perform.

AMBASSADOR & JUNIOR AMBASSADOR

The Ambassador competition is a way to celebrate those who have a heart for service. Delegates will assemble a portfolio of their community service work and positive things she has done to make a difference with her Princess of America state/regional title. Portfolio must be turned in at pageant check-in. Ambassador forms will be sent separately.

Delegates will also speak with the judges about their journey with Princess of America. Delegates will have a panel interview with the judges and be asked questions based on the portfolio and what they have achieved with their Princess of America state title.

NOTE: The Junior Superstar & Junior Ambassador titles will come from the junior divisions (Tiny Miss, Little Miss, and Preteen Miss age divisions combined). Superstar & Ambassador titles will come from the senior divisions (Teen Miss, Junior Miss, and Miss age divisions combined).

PLATFORM

It is required that all national delegates select a platform. After all, Princess of America's motto is "A Crown With A Cause".

What is a platform? A platform is your 'cause'. Choose something that sparks passion within you. You can choose a specific organization that you volunteer with or even create your own organization. It can even be something as simple as promoting kindness in your community. Know your platform, and be prepared to potentially answer platform based questions in your interview or for on stage question.

To also be considered for a Superstar or Ambassador title please submit a talent video or a letter of recommendation when sending your headshot.

After you have submitted your application and \$50 application fee please allow 2-4 weeks for acceptance. After acceptance, the remaining \$450 entry fee must be paid in full before your crown and banner are ordered.
